Game Rules

1. Read with your parent (or grandparent, aunt, uncle, step-parent, babysitter) for at least 15 minutes each day. Here are some ideas:

You can take turns reading pages or chapters.

- ⇒ Try reading different character parts.
- ⇒ You can each read your own book (or magazine) at the same time.
- ⇒ Read a recipe together.
- ⇒ Read the lyrics of your favorite song.
- ⇒ Do a crossword puzzle or a word jumble.
- ⇒ Play a board game!

2. You still have to follow your teacher's daily reading requirement and turn in your weekly reading log. Your PARP reading can be a part of your daily assignment or, even better, in addition to it!
3. Complete daily the "Reading Sheet" for each week of PARP.
4. Turn in your PARP Handbook every Friday of PARP (except for the last week) to receive your PARP stamp. If you get 3 PARP stamps, you will receive the PARP prize at the end of the program. If you are absent on a PARP collection day, hold onto your book until the following collection date.
5. Complete the weekly PARP challenge to receive extra PARP prizes!

JANUARY

FEBRUARY

- 2/1:** Book Swap – bring in a gently used book in a bag labeled with your name, grade and teacher; books will be collected from each teacher
- 2/2:** Book Swap – Pick out a “new” book during lunchtime; you have to donate a book in order to select a new one
- 2/3:** Turn in PARP Handbook (Week 2 Reading Sheet and Challenge 2 completed)
- 2/7:** Read a Shirt Day – Show your Ocean spirit and wear a shirt with appropriate wording
- 2/9:** Turn in PARP Handbook (Week 3 Reading Sheet and Challenge 3 completed) NOTE – YOU'RE TURNING YOUR BOOK IN ON A THURSDAY
- 2/10:** PARP prizes handed out; CLOSING PARTY!

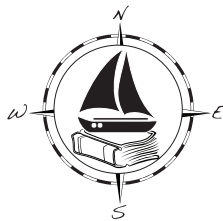
